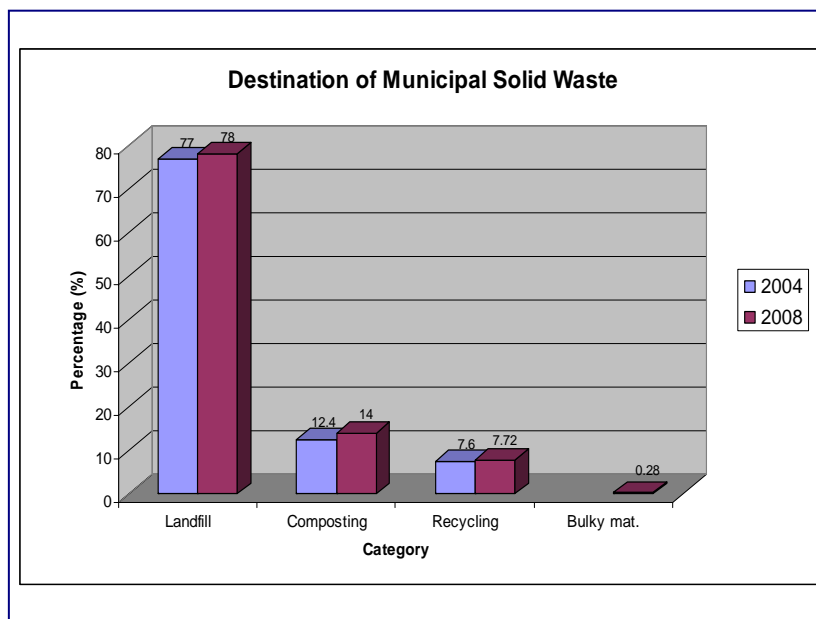

In Lebanon, there is no sorting at the source. In Greater Beirut and part of Mount Lebanon, there are two sorting plants, one composting plant, one sanitary landfill for rejects (Naameh) and one for bulky material and demolition waste (Bsalim). Outside Beirut, there is one sanitary landfill in Zahle.
