Indicator: Access to safe drinking water

Definition:

This indicator represents the proportion of population with access to an adequate amount of safe drinking water (at least 20 lit per day and per person).

- Access to water is the access rate to infrastructures delivering safe drinking water.
- Safe drinking water is water that does not contain biological or chemical pathogenic agents at levels directly detrimental to health, and is regularly monitored by competent authorities and considered acceptable.

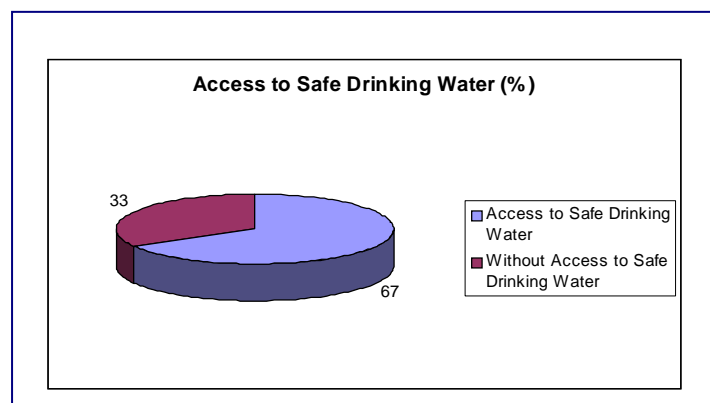
