The percentage of population not connected to any type of network (neither public, artesian well or private) is 4.7%

The lower percentage in 2000 could be due to survey errors or different sampling procedures.

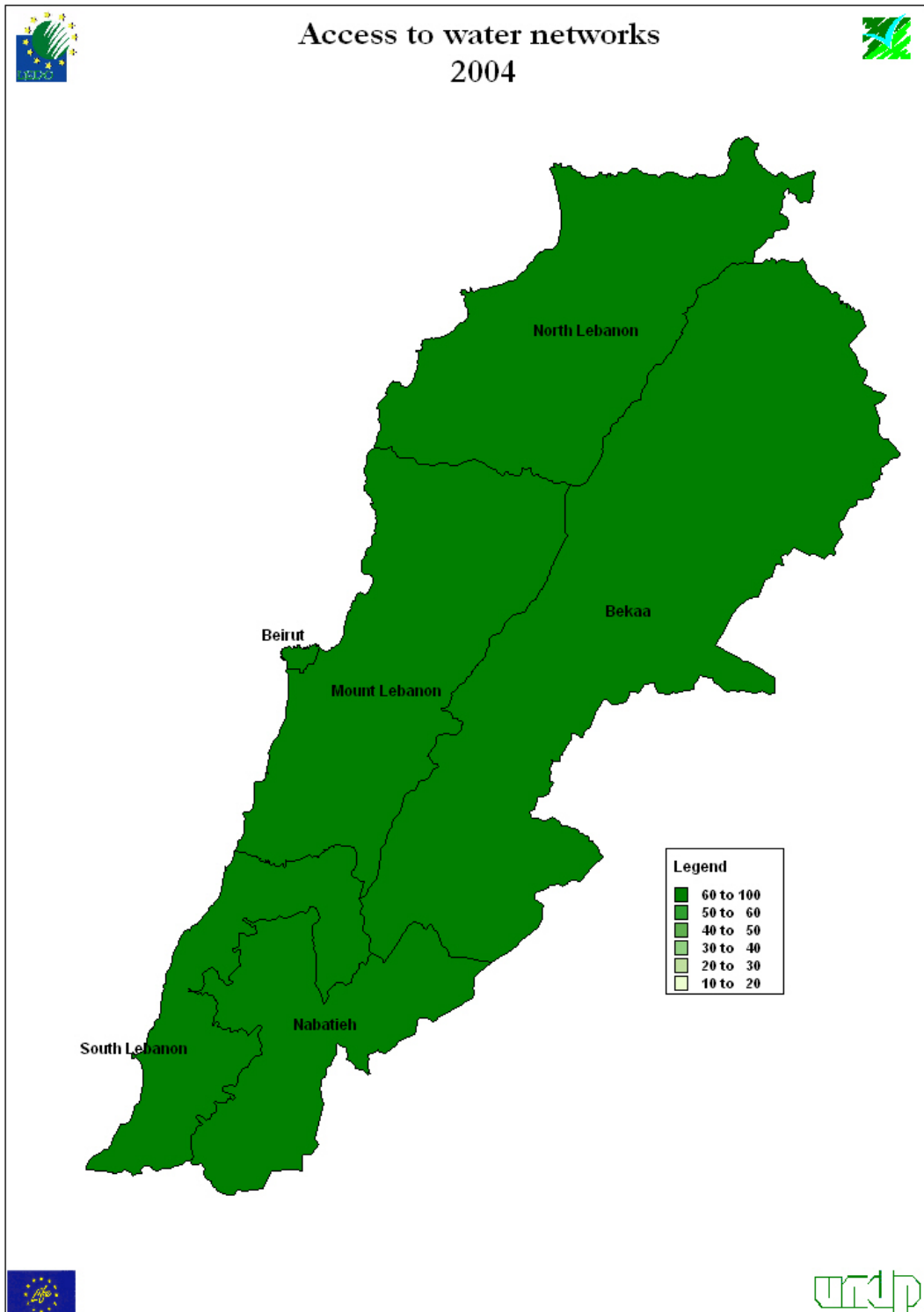

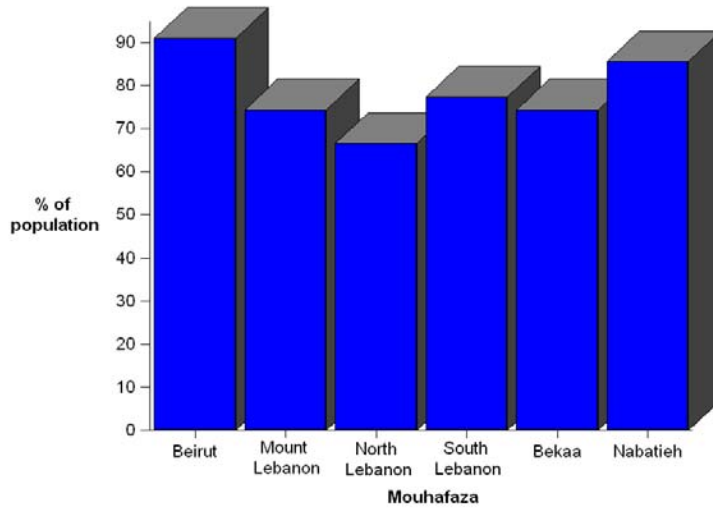
